Reviews should be sent to the Reviews editor at the e-mail address given on the IPS web-site and in the current yearbook

Please comply with the Society's style:

- Send your article as WORD document
- Include an abstract of ca. 100 words
- Font size should be 12-point for the main text, 11 for longer quotations and 10 for footnotes
- Single spaced
- Use footnotes, not endnotes
- Justified for all text, including long quotations and footnotes
- All long quotations should be indented on both sides (0.5 cm)
- Comply with the MHRA Style Guide for citation etc.
- Avoid the use of bold or underlining
- As the complete references are available in the footnotes a separate bibliography should not be included
- If possible, translation for all non-English quotations should be used in the main text with the original quotation provided in the footnotes
- The names of authors should be written in small capitals, always give the full name of the author(s) and editors
